

BYLAW NO. 50-91

A BYLAW OF THE R.M. OF MOOSE CREEK NO. 33 TO DESIGNATE THE PROPERTY KNOWN MUNICIPALLY AS MOOSE CREEK UNITED CHURCH AND CEMETERY AS BEING OF HISTORICAL VALUE.

Whereas Part III of The Heritage Property Act, 1980, authorizes the council of a municipality to enact bylaws to designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of historical value and interest:

Whereas the Council of the R.M. of Moose Creek No. 33 has caused to be served on the owners of the lands and premises known as Moose Creek United Church and Cemetery at Pt. NE35-6-3-W2 a Notice of Intention to so designate the aforesaid real property and has caused such Notice of Intention to be published in at least two issues of a newspaper with general circulation in the municipality with the first publication at least twenty-one (21) days prior to the date of consideration of the bylaw and with the last publication at least seven (7) days prior to the date of the consideration:

Whereas no Notice of Objection to the proposed designation has been served on the Administrator of the municipality:

Therefore, the Council of the R.M. of Moose Creek No. 33 enacts as follows:

1. There is designated as being of historical value the real property know as Moose Creek United Church and Cemetery at PT. NE 35-6-3-W2.
The significance of the site is as follows:
to preserve the heritage of the Church
2. The Administrator is hereby authorized to cause a certified copy of this bylaw to be registered against the property described above in the proper land titles office.
3. The Adminsitrator is hereby authorized to cuase a copy of this bylaw to be served on the owner of the aforesaid property and on the Minister of the Saskatchewan Family Foundation - Heritage Branch and cause notice of the passing of this bylaw.
