Councillor Melissa Gervais declared a conflict of interest regarding the Foreman Position as a family member was one of the candidates and left the council chambers at 9:42am.

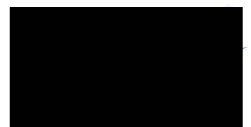
Foreman Position **189/26** Dietze:
